FORWARD EVENTS FOR YOUR DIARY

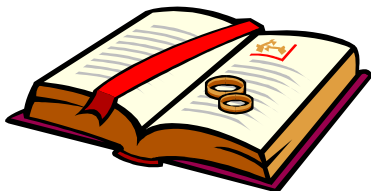
Church members meeting to be held on Thursday 16th September at 7.30pm; agenda available next week. All members urged to attend and other regular worshippers welcome
